



# More room for innovation in manufacturing – EIT Manufacturing expands in Vienna

Vienna, 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2021. In April 2020, the EIT Manufacturing Co-Location Center (CLC) East was founded in Vienna and it is the first location of a Knowledge and Innovation Community (KIC) of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), a body of the European Union, in Austria. One year later, the young organization headed by Johannes Hunschofsky doubles its office space to meet the needs of a fast-growing team as well as to best serve the increasing demands of the local and regional stakeholders. On 22<sup>nd</sup> June, the new office space was officially opened.

Only last year, the CLC East started operations in its new offices in tz2 of the Technology Center in Seestadt Vienna with 13 available work stations. From six employees in December 2020, the Viennese team already counts 12 members in June 2021 — with a rising trend —, who serve twelve countries in Central and Eastern Europe with its EIT Manufacturing activities and programmes out of the Austrian capital. EIT Manufacturing's goal is to strengthen cross-national collaboration between industry, academia and research and foster innovation in the European manufacturing industry.

"In only a very short time, we have been able to establish EIT Manufacturing as driving force in Vienna to promote innovation in manufacturing. This has only been possible with the great support we have received from the city of Vienna and due to our cooperation with the Vienna Business Agency. We will develop our collaboration even further in the future to combine our strengths for the good of the Viennese manufacturing industry", says Johannes Hunschofsky, Managing Director of EIT Manufacturing CLC East.

"In Vienna, digitalisation means finding and supporting solutions for the people. On a global scale, especially our small and medium-sized enterprises are challenged to compete in the long run. This is why we are proud to have EIT Manufacturing in Vienna as an international player to strengthen the business location for digitalisation as well as our companies operating here in the city", says **Peter Hanke**, Executive City Councillor of Finance, Business, Labour, International Affairs and Vienna Public Utilities.

# Strengthening the business location Vienna through cooperation

The Vienna Business Agency, who establishes and runs the Technology Center Seestadt at the edge of the Austrian federal capital as a technology and innovation hub, also recognized the potential of the rapidly growing location of EIT Manufacturing. To jointly boost Vienna as a location for research and science, the Vienna Business Agency and EIT Manufacturing CLC East have put two cooperation agreements in place.

**Gerhard Hirczi**, Managing Director of the Vienna Business Agency about the collaboration with EIT Manufacturing CLC East: "The Technology Center in the Seestadt is already a hotspot for new technologies, digital production and the Viennese hub for manufacturing technology. EIT Manufacturing as European institution fits perfectly in this environment and ensures additional international visibility."

On 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2021, the new, additional office space of EIT Manufacturing CLC East was opened and the two cooperation agreements between the Vienna Business Agency and EIT Manufacturing CLC East were officially signed. In honour of this occasion, high-level representatives of the city of Vienna visited the CLC

# EIT Manufacturing supports local projects and companies in Vienna


As part of the event programme, various Viennese projects and companies, which have been supported by EIT Manufacturing since 2020, have been presented during the office visit. One of them is **Incus**, a company for lithography-based high-performance metal additive manufacturing, BoostUp! 2020 participant and also one of the neighbours of EIT Manufacturing CLC East in the Technology Center Seestadt. Also **cleanAIR**, a mobile air cleaner with an integrated disinfection function for closed rooms up to 50 m² was demonstrated by Univ.Prof. Dipl.-Ing. Dr.techn. Friedrich Bleicher, Head of the Institute for Production Engineering and Photonic Technologies (IFT) at the TU Wien, a member of EIT Manufacturing. The low-cost air cleaner was developed by a consortium consisting of the IFT TU Wien, AIT, HPM Technologie GmbH and AQA GmbH during the Crisis-Response-Initiative of the EIT. Especially in places with many people, cleanAIR ensures a healthier and safer ambient air. First tests of the air purification system have been very successful, also the disinfection mode has been examined in various laboratory experiments. The next step for cleanAIR is to obtain the necessary certifications for the market launch.

### Start of joint activities and initiatives

The two cooperation agreements between the Vienna Business Agency and EIT Manufacturing CLC East are the foundation for a successful collaboration between the two organisations, which will be further developed in the future. In the context of the cooperation, EIT Manufacturing CLC East also hosted the Manufacturing Days from  $10^{th}$ - $12^{th}$  May 2021 as part of the ViennaUP'21, the largest decentral start-up festival in Europe and organized by the Vienna Business Agency. The intention of this first Viennese festival for the manufacturing industry was to give young and innovative manufacturing start-ups a stage for their ventures and to help them establish connections to large industrial players. In the future, the cooperation between the Vienna Business Agency and EIT Manufacturing CLC East will be extended to other projects in order to jointly strengthen the Viennese manufacturing industry on a European and international level.

# **Background Information**

CLC East serves twelve countries in Central and Eastern Europe: Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Greece, Hungary, North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, and Slovenia, of which eleven are EIT RIS eligible countries, being considered modest and moderate innovators according to the European Innovation Scoreboard. Therefore, the Regional Innovation Scheme (RIS) Pillar Leadership and its eight local Hubs in the CLC East Region are strongly involved in the CLC East network and its activities. CLC East works in close cooperation with its nine full members from industry, research and academia: Atos, the Czech Technical University in Prague, Joanneum Research, Jožef Stefan Institute, LMS – Laboratory for Manufacturing Systems & Automation, Magna, the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava, the Technical University Vienna, and voestalpine High Performance Metals, and its network partners AM-Austria and the Vienna Business Agency. EIT Manufacturing CLC East is additionally supported by three Austrian Ministries (Federal Ministry Digital and Economic Affairs; Federal Ministry Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology; Federal Ministry Education, Science and Research) as well as the Austrian Research Promotion Agency (FFG).
