Fueled by a strong interdisciplinary and trusted system has regional innovation centers located in Paris, Darmstadt, Gothenburg, San Sebastian, Vienna and Milan. In particular, the CLC (Co-Location Centre) South based in Milan is an integral part of EIT Manufacturing governance and acts as connection point with local ecosystems. It initiates, hosts, and implements the various activities of EIT Manufacturing and provides a platform for discussion and elaboration of innovative ideas. The CLC South identifies and builds new possibilities to further substantiate EIT Manufacturing's long-term sustainability and is actively involved in helping to secure funding for Innovation, Education and Business Creation activities. About the position

The XR2LEARN project aims at establishing a cross-border innovation community for XR (extended reality) in learning, bringing XR technology providers, application designers, education experts, application developers, end-users and decision makers in direct access to communicate, collaborate and matchmake interests, enabling also bottom-up innovation creation. Within the project, EIT Manufacturing will contribute to the design and establishment of the XR2Learn ecosystem, bringing in its already established community of learners, training providers and manufacturing companies. EIT Manufacturing will capitalize on its experience from building and running the proprietary Digital Learning Platform skillsmove.eu, integrating in with the XR2Learn digital platform.

The position is about managing and implementing the activities of EIT Manufacturing South in the XR2LEARN project in coordination with the Project Leader, support in general the activities of EIT Manufacturing South regarding this topic, and follow throughout the project development.

In addition, you are responsible for the scouting of EU funding opportunities and coordination of grant applications. The position holder is involved in the proposal phase coordination, including networking activity, partners' scouting and writing. You already have a proven track record of developing new research grant proposals in a technical

discipline. Advising and helping position EIT Manufacturing's partners in EU programmes to increase their participation in these projects is a key activity within this role. You will also provide support in the reporting of EU and national funded projects for EIT Manufacturing CLC South legal entity. You have past experience in accounting and financial reporting for H2020.

- Responsible for the coordination, implementation and project management of European-funded projects for the Co-Location Center (CLC), i.e:
 - Project kick-off, scope of work and definition of responsibilities/tasks
 - Coordination of project activities with relevant Consortium Partners
 - Budget planning / cost control
 - KPI definition and monitoring
 - Procurement and admin tasks related to the funded project
 - Continuous and final reporting
 - Promote project results within the EIT Manufacturing network and facilitate technology transfer and exchange of best practices
 - Support the implementation of communication and dissemination activities
- Reporting on the activities performed within the CLC (e.g. end of year reports)
- Drive fundraising activities for accessing EU/national/local public funding sources
- Create and manage collaborative consortia definition for new proposals
- Participate in ad-hoc focus groups related to specific Innovation strategic thematic areas
- Project cost reporting and support in the periodic EC progress reports preparation and management
- Prepare relevant documentation for internal or external audits

Qualifications

- Bachelor/Master degree - preferably in Engineering, Business or Economics
- Knowledge of European funded programs (e.g. Horizon Europe) and the corresponding regulations regarding European grant funding
- Previous experience in the manufacturing sector (e.g. Industry 4.0) and XR (extended reality) is a plus
- Fluent in English language; proficiency in Italian is a plus
- Good writing skills in English
- Excellent knowledge of Microsoft Office tools (e.g. Excel)
