The eighth edition of Advanced Factories will be held from 9 to 11 April at Fira de Barcelona Gran Vía

Europe's largest industry innovation community will lead the discussion on the net zero goal, addressing the challenges facing the manufacturing sector and the ongoing initiatives

Blanca Chocarro, EIT Community Program Manager at EIT Manufacturing, will address the industry's challenge to achieve zero emissions by 2050, as established by the European Union. Chocarro will be joined by experts to provide a comprehensive overview of some of the initiatives driving the transition to a more sustainable industry, through successful case studies. They will also address the main challenges facing this transition in terms of technology development, assessing current progress and barriers to implementation. Efforts at European level, such as the Net Zero Industry Act, will also be discussed in this round table.
