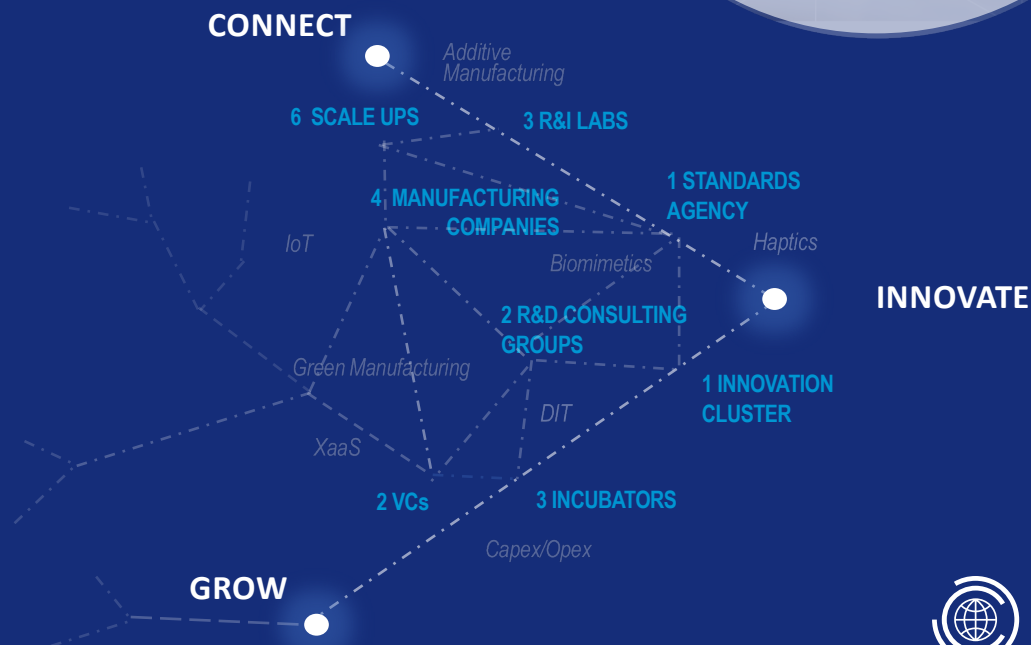
3 DEEPINC SCHOOLS
